## About the Registry

The VicPD Bike Registry is a voluntary program that allows you to register your bicycle with the Victoria Police Department. Registering your bicycle will greatly assist in its recovery if it is lost or stolen and will help us reunite you with it.

To register you must be willing to provide personal contact information and particulars on your bicycle. This information will be entered in a Victoria Police database which will then be accessible to any police department in the Province of British Columbia.

The personal information you provide will be used for the Bike Registry Program and for law enforcement investigation purposes. The personal information you provide will be retained for a period of 5 years.
