		<i>Police Act</i> Section 69(1) & 69(2): Meetings and hearings open to public	
(1) (2)	Subject to subsection (2), every meeting and hearing of a board or a committee must be open to the public. If it believes that any of the following matters will arise in a meeting or hearing held by it, a board or committee may order that the portion of the meeting during which the matter will arise be held in private:		
	(a)	a matter concerning public security, the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to serious impair effective policing or law enforcement;	
	(b)	a matter concerning a person's financial or personal affairs, if the person's interest in the matter outweighs the public's interest in the matter;	
	(c)	a matter concerning labour contract discussions, labour management relations, layoffs or another personnel matter;	
	(d)	a matter concerning information that a person has requested he or she be allowed to give in private the board or committee.
